

A5 KILSBY TO WEEDON Multi-Disciplinary Project

Update Bulletin 14 – 3.10.2019

Please note that due to a forecast of heavy rainfall, we will **NOT** be carrying out resurfacing works in **Phase 5 (from Daventry Road (Norton) to B4036 Long Buckby)** between **8pm Friday 4th and 6am Monday 7th October 2019**.

However, we will be carrying out main drainage works in **Phase 6 (from B4036 Long Buckby to B5385 Watford Gap)** between **8pm Friday 4th and 6am Saturday 5th October 2019**.

This means that the **A5 will remain open to through traffic between Kilsby and Weedon Bec between 6am Saturday 5th and 8pm Monday 7th October 2019**.

Main drainage works in **Phase 6** are being carried out overnight between **8pm and 6am Monday to Friday inclusive until late October 2019**.

Application of the postponed High Friction Surfacing at the **Daventry Road (Norton) / Whilton junction** is now planned to be carried out **between 8pm Wednesday 9th and 6am Thursday 10th October 2019**.

In order to carry out these works, minor remedial works and resurface two lay-bys in **Phase 4** on the same night, **the A5 will be closed between Weedon Lane (opposite the Heart of the Shires Shopping Village and Daventry Road (Norton))**.

NB: Please note that access across the A5 at the Daventry Road (Norton) and Whilton junctions will NOT be available on that night.

Resurfacing of **Phase 5 (from Daventry Road (Norton) to B4036 Long Buckby)** is now planned **between 8pm Friday 11th and 6am Monday 14th October 2019**.

NB: Please note that access across the A5 at the B4036 Long Buckby junction will NOT be available at any time during these resurfacing works.

Dates for the application of High Friction Surfacing required at the **B4036 Long Buckby junction** will be advised nearer the time.

Please note that all our planned road works may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
